Memo #03-2022 Holy Land Pilgrimage

Beloved Pilgrims to the Holy Land,
May the peace and love of the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ continue to abide with us all.

We are writing to advise that your E-Ticket Number for the sixth pilgrimage to the holy land coming up on May 21 – May 29, 2022, has been forwarded to your Email addresses. Please take immediate step to select your seat. If you want to upgrade to Premium or Business class, you should please go on unitedair.com to upgrade or call the Customer Service of the airline.

Please note that for those who are yet to purchase their tickets and planning to fly from Airports different from Newark-New Jersey they should book their flights to leave US on the 21st arriving at Ben Gurion Airport, Tel- Aviv on 22nd. Return Trip shall leave Tel-Aviv Israel on 29th, arriving back in USA on 30th May 2022. Your Covid test must be taken within 72 hours before departure and must be negative to go on the Holy Pilgrimage. It is also important to know that you are required to have taken your booster shot.

By April, Pilgrims will be advised of the type of dresses depending on the weather situation in Israel but please forward your T/Shirt size to the coordinator -Sister Umoru as soon as possible. Thirty-two major sites of biblical importance will be visited, including baptism at Jordan, Worship Service in a chapel on the Mount of Transfiguration, administration of Holy Communion at the Garden Tomb, fire- seasoned prayer on Mount Camel and Mount Olive, and full Service injected with praise worship and prophetic exercise on the Sea of Galilee. It will be a great experience in 5-Star hotels saturated with sumptuous buffets. For 9 days/ 8 nights, accompanied by a knowledgeable tour guide provided by America-Israel Tours, and transported by a private, chartered, luxurious bus, the holy pilgrims will travel from Tel Aviv to Tiberias, to the Dead Sea, to Jerusalem with important stops along the way which include Jaffa, Caesarea, Mt Carmel, Jericho, Gate of Damascus, Bethany, Meggido, Nazareth, Mt. of Precipice, Cruise on the Sea of Galilee, Capernaum, Mt. of the Beatitudes, Mt. Hermon, Mt. Tabor/Mt. of the Transfiguration, renewed Baptism in river Jordan, Dead Sea, Messada, Qumran, Jericho, Mt. of Olives, Bethlehem, Church of the Nativity, Garden of Gethsemane, Calvary and the Wailing Wall, Via Dolorosa.
