Memo-Conv-Com #07/2024 Oct. 14, 2024 Convention Communiqué Implementation #1

Beloved of the blessed Lord and Savior Jesus Christ,

Please, following are the first set of Resolutions taken at the last 7th Convention of the Diocese. You are required to check those areas that you have implemented and provide the time -line for the implementation of those that are yet to be implemented. The completed Questionnaire is expected to be received by the Diocesan General Secretary on or before October 31, 2024. Thanks for your cooperation.

HOUSE KEEPING

- Every parish shall maintain an appropriate Insurance coverage for its structural properties, all assets and contingent and precarious liabilities. Default or failure to comply shall not create any obligation for any parish, state, region, diocese or church.
- Every parish/shepherd shall ensure the maintenance of appropriate Life Policy of at least \$15,000 or higher for the shepherd in case of death. Default or failure shall not create an obligation for any parish, state, region, diocese or the Church.
- Shepherds shall receive their compensations/emoluments through the Payroll/W2 System, allow for Social Security and Medicare/Medicaid Tax deductions to be able to enjoy the appropriate benefits when they attain the age of 65 and beyond.
- The Church/diocese reaffirms the Church's stand against the practices of lesbian, gay, bi-sexual, transgender and queer. It was promulgated during the 3rd convention held at Los Angeles. At this 7th Convention today May 17, 2024 it is once again reaffirmed.
- All prophecy provided to members of the church should be presented to the Shepherd for approval before being acted upon
- Importation of Social Artists into our choir barricade and praise worship of individuals within the Sanctuary of God shall remain outlawed.
- Strong and articulate members from each region shall be identified and appointed into the Directorate of Compliance and Investigation. The directorate shall now operate



YOUTH ENGAGEMENT


- Inclusion of qualified youth effectively in the spiritual and administrative processes of the parish including Worship Service Rosters, Parochial Committees, Harvest Committees, Evangelism, Various Ministries and projects of the parish.
- Entrusting the Management of the internet, information Technology and Media to them.
- Mentorship: Timothy was mentored by Paul Apostle (1 Timothy 6:20-21, 2 Tim. 2). Every shepherd shall now have the responsibility to prepare a strata – various levels of capable elders with qualified training, experience and exposure to mentor the various age brackets and functional departments of each parish.
- Partnership: Specific programs demonstrating collaboration between the older members and the younger members such as men’s Retreat, bringing them into three/seven elders prayer for people, involving them in crusades, leading Sunday Schools and Bible Classes.(1 Thess. 3:2)
- "Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." (2 Timothy 2:15, KJV) Spiritual authority is not self-appointed but recognized by the church through testing and proven character. The truth is consistent. Encourage the youth to study and improve themselves continually, identify those that are sincerely humble, committed and selfless for higher recognition and responsibilities.

WOMEN ENGAGEMENT AND EMPOWERMENT

- Serve as Chairperson, treasurer or holder of any other office in the Parochial Committee except as Secretary of the Church.
- Serve as Chairperson or holder of any office within the Harvest Committee.
- Serve as Chairperson or holder of any office within any of the Parish Ministries.
- Evangelize/Preach the good News of the Kingdom of God in a Crusade or even sharing the Word of God with the congregation after the normal Sabbath day Service but cannot deliver the Sermon, conduct Revival or mount the Pulpit.
